Course content:

Students will have the opportunity to take an AS or A level in Psychology. The course content for AS and the first year of A level will aim to develop students broad knowledge and understanding of the core areas of Psychology. During their second year, students studying A level will engage in issues and debates in Psychology as well as studying, indepth, a number of key topics.

Assessment:

AS level: (first year of course: most, if not all, students will not sit the AS exam)

Skills acquired:

- Knowledge and understanding
- Interpretation and analysis
- Research skills
- Presentation skills; an ability to explain behaviours from different psychological perspectives.

Links with other subjects:

Biology PE, Maths, Geography, English.

Possible careers:

Psychology professions e.g. Clinical Psychologist, Sports Psychologist or Educational Psychologist. Any people-centred career eg Teaching; Counselling; Retail Trade or Management.

Prior experience:

Minimum: GCSE Level 5 in Maths, English and Biology [or Double Science] to take A level Psychology
