Outstanding A-Level Results Reach A New High August 2017

Overall 38% A*-A and 64% A*-B

*for the third year in succession, easily beating all local sixth form colleges
in Herefordshire & Worcestershire and in the top 20% of Sixth Forms nationally*

Overall nearly two thirds of entries resulted in B grades or higher and the average point score per student is in excess of that achieved by many grammar and independent schools. A significantly larger proportion of students at JMHS achieve the highest grades compared to the rest of England and Wales. As a result JMHS students progress to top universities, excellent apprenticeship and employment opportunities.

Our students attained on average nearly half a grade above target in each of their subjects. In Psychology and Geography over 75% of grades were A*, A or B and in Maths, Chemistry, Further Maths and French over 50% of students achieved top A*/A grades.
