Post-16 bus passes

For a post-16 bus pass you will need to apply to the Council where your household council tax is paid to. For Herefordshire Council, if you meet the eligibility conditions you can apply for a subsidised bus pass online: <u>https://www.herefordshire.gov.uk/info/200187/public_transport/166/school_and_college_transport/2</u>. The subsidised fees for 2017-18 are as follows: Autumn term £276, Spring term £276 and Summer term £213.

16-19 Bursary

The 16-19 Bursary Fund aims to encourage participation by young people who face financial barriers to learning. There are two types of bursary, namely:

- 1. A bursary of up to £1,200 a year for young people in the following defined vulnerable groups:
 - a. in care;
 - b. care leavers;
 - c. young people in receipt of income support or universal credit in their own name;
 - d. disabled young people in receipt of Employment Support Allowance <u>AND</u> Disability Living Allowance or Personal Independence Payments in their own name.
- 2. Discretionary bursary awards made by the Sixth Form to young people in ways that best fit their needs and circumstances. Bursary awards are targeted towards those young people who face the greatest financial barriers to participation; such as the costs of transport, meals, books and equipment.

Details on how to apply for the 16-19 Bursary will be sent home at the start of the autumn term, with applications reviewed by the Sixth Form Leadership Team by the end of September and students notified whether they have been successful in early October.
