In addition to the planned curriculum, students' experience is enhanced with a range of educational visits to support subject-specific studies and input from a number of external presenters.

Curriculum extension opportunities exist for study for the Extended Project Qualification which is equal to half an A Level and involves 90 hours of independent research.

Each student is assigned a mentor who will hold regular target-setting and review meetings with the student and support them through their university, apprenticeship or job applications /preparation. The mentor will meet each student at least once per month.
