Sustained excellent outcomes for students

Overall 30% A*-A and 60% A*-B

(Averaged over the past three years)

Over 95% of students into their first choice of university

Over the last three years just over 60% of entries resulted in B grades or higher and the average point score per student is in excess of that achieved by many grammar and independent schools. A significantly larger proportion of students at JMHS achieve the highest grades compared to the rest of England and Wales. As a result JMHS students progress to top universities, excellent apprenticeship and employment opportunities.
