Regenerating places	This topic looks at how local places vary economically and socially with change driven by local, national and global processes. As well as the relative success of regeneration and rebranding for individual and groups. This is looked at through key questions: - 1) How and why do places vary? 2) Why might regeneration be needed? 3) Who are the players in regeneration? 4) Evaluate if regeneration can be successful.	Formal assessment: 45 minute end of topic assessment including skills questions, short answer questions and an extended writing task. Coastal Landscapes	This question will be assessed using a ranger of short 6 mark questions to longer 20 marks essay questions. This topic looks at the flows of energy and the characteristics that operate at costal systems to produce distinctive coastal landscapes. This topic addresses how the coast is increasingly threatened by human activities. This is looked at through key questions:- 1) Why are coastal landscapes different and what processes cause these differences? 2) How do characteristic coastal landforms contribute to coastal landscapes? 3) How do coastal erosion and sea level change alter the physical characteristics of coastlines and increase risks? 4) How can coastlines be managed to meet the needs of all players? This question will be assessed using a ranger of short 6 mark questions to longer 20 marks essay questions.	Formal assessment: 45 minute end of topic assessment skills questions, short answer questions and an extended writing task.
