# **Year 10 Imedia Spring Overview**

## **Spring Term curriculum**

During the spring term we will be studying a unit on the topic of graphics.

We will begin by revisiting previous knowledge on the types of file type and adapt these to look at those which are suitable for a graphics project. Following on from this we will study what compression is, DPI and consider how successful a variety of different graphics are.

We will then continue by using our previous knowledge to source graphics for our book cover project and plan the timeframe of the assignment considering what the scenario is asking for. Following this we will begin to make a book cover considering colours, layout, fonts suitable for a target audience.

# By the end of the Spring term, students should be able to:

- ✓ Give the advantages and disadvantages of different graphic file types
- ✓ Clearly describe what is meant by a target audience, giving suitable target audiences for different graphics
- ✓ Analyse what a scenario is asking for and respond accordingly
- ✓ Decide upon a timeframe for the project by listing the tasks which need to be completed
- ✓ Source suitable images for the project and decide upon how these may be adapted for use.

#### Assessment

Students will be assessed formatively through completion of homework as well as through imedia coursework completion. At this stage this will take the form of a tracker listed tasks completed or partially completed to prevent excess feedback being provided.

### Useful additional resources to support and challenge learning

Students should look at a range of graphic types in addition to those studied in class, including magazines, book covers from a variety of target audiences/genres, CD covers, cereal boxes, billboards
