<b>Why is our understanding of the world wrong?</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Students will reflect on their understanding of the world.</li><li>• Students will explore and address common misconceptions about the world (rich vs poor, Africa, population growth, natural hazards and climate change).</li><li>• Students will sketch a line graph to show how the world population has changed over time.</li><li>• Students will know reasons why population growth will slow down.</li><li>• Students will understand that Africa is an economically and culturally diverse continent which (in some countries), has seen rapid growth in the past 30 years.</li><li>• Students will know how to calculate percentage change.</li><li>• Students will understand how the media shapes our understanding of the world.</li><li>• Students will know improvements to a number of development indicators such as poverty rate.</li></ul>	<p><b>Formal assessment:</b> 30 minute end of topic assessment including multiple choice questions, skills questions, short answer questions and an extended writing task.</p> <p><b>Informal assessment:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• True/false quizzes</li><li>• Homework</li><li>• Review questions</li><li>• Literacy tasks</li></ul>
