

## **Year 10 Travel and Tourism Summer Overview**

The Tourism course is made up of 3 compulsory components. Students will sit their tourism exam next January 2022 with an opportunity to resit that Summer. Component 1 and 3 are assessed by two pieces of coursework.

Students have previously been completing Component 1 in one of their sessions which includes looking at a variety of different tourist destinations. This has included analysing how different areas and attractions and accommodation appeal to different visitor types and how different attractions can work with others in order to be successful.

In their second session they have been covering work for the exam, focusing on how sustainable tourism can be and how it can be managed to be more so.

### **Summer Term curriculum**

Students will use the Summer term to continue to prepare for the unit 2 examination and will look at issues of tourism safety in terms of transport safety as well as the risks posed to tourists by a series of health, climatic and other hazards. There will be continued opportunities to look at the role of Government in tourism in keeping tourists safe but also in their use of DMO's (Destination Management organisations such as Visit England).

In their other session students will be completing coursework tasks. They should ensure all of their work is submitted to the best of their ability and any websites and other sources are referenced appropriately to avoid plagiarism. There can be no extended deadlines for this and it is essential they keep to the deadline. Students will be complete their second coursework project which will look at the role of an established tourist organisation such as Drayton Manor and analyse how effective it is as a tourist destination and meeting its aims. Students will also analyse its interrelationships and argue to what extent its partnerships allow it to meet its aims.

During the Summer term students will learn exam techniques appropriate for past papers for Unit 2 leading up to a formal Summer mock exam in the Summer term.
