## **Health and Social Care Cambridge Technical Level 3**

Year Group: 12

Students will begin the course with an introduction to Health and Social Care. The aim of the introduction is to give students the confidence with the key terminology and distinct areas covered within the course.

## Students will cover:

- What are the three sectors and the careers in Health and Social Care
- Who are the users of these services and what are their needs?
- What provision is in our area

Students will study three of the six units overall in this course during Year 12, these are:

• **Key Learning Points**: Coursework Unit - Unit 1 Building Positive Relationships in Health and Social Care

**Topic** Students will complete two of the sets tasks required for this unit, these will cover the range of communication methods required to build positive relationships within Health, social care and child care settings. In order to gain a deeper understanding how relationships can be formed students will study theories of communication and understand how these can be applied to specific roles and service users.

**Key Learning Points**: Examined Unit -Unit 4 Anatomy and Physiology for Health and Social Care

**Topic** Students will develop an understanding of the cardiovascular system including how malfunctions occur and how best to treat and care for people with cardiovascular malfunctions. Students will also learn how ventilation and gas exchange occurs in the respiratory system and the treatment and care of a variety of respiratory malfunctions.

• **Key Learning Points**: Examined Unit - Unit 3 Health, Safety and Security in Health and Social Care

**Topic** Students will understand potential hazards in health, social care and child care settings. The students will understand how legislation ,policies and procedures promote health, safety and security in health , social care and child cared environments. They will then understand the roles and responsibilities involved in health, safety and security in health , social care and child care environments.
