Health and Social Care Cambridge Technical Level 3

Students will study the three remaining units during Year 13. During the first term students will cover Unit 14 - The impact of long-term physiological conditions with Mrs Law and Unit 24 – Public Health with Mrs Woolley.

Unit 14 - The impact of long-term physiological conditions

Students will complete non-examined assessment coursework for this unit.

Students will:

- Know what long term physiological conditions are and their causes and symptoms
- Understand the effects of long-term physiological conditions
- Be able to support individuals with long term physiological conditions to plan their care and support.

Unit 24 – Public Health

Students will study the origins of public health policy and legislation, looking how historical event have developed public health initiatives. Students would then understand the importance of statistics and be able to use these to look at birth rate and life expectancy. Students will research the main health concerns affecting our nation and what initiatives are in place to safeguard the future of individuals. Students will then be able to explain the role of national organisations and practitioners in promoting public health.

Students will completed non-examined assessment coursework for this unit.
