### Main Purpose of the Role:

## Main Duties and Responsibilities

- 1. Teach the programme developed by JM staff and adapt it to the needs of individual students to increase their knowledge stored in long term memory, develop their understanding and address misconceptions
- 2. Set high expectations of behaviour, work rate and effort and report to your line manager where these expectations are not met
- 3. Give continuous and constructive feedback to students to help them develop their knowledge, understanding and confidence
- 4. Give clear and regular feedback to the student's class teacher via the progress proforma and face to face meetings
- 5. Participate in training led by JM staff on effectively teaching the catch up programme and on safeguarding
- 6. Uphold the JM staff code of conduct and report any safeguarding or other concerns using My Concern
