3. Sadly, those who may be seen as 'diverse' often face discrimination. Write a definition of direct and indirect discrimination.
4. Why is it important we challenge discrimination if we see this in the workplace? Why do some people find this difficult to do?
5. Research a case in health and social care where discrimination has taken place. What was the basis of discrimination. What were the outcome. What is your opinion about the case?
