

Top-Level Overview for Key Stage 4 Curriculum: French

1. Endpoint for the end of Key Stage 4:

Language Knowledge: Use a wide range of **GCSE vocabulary** and core grammatical structures accurately. Understand and apply **past, present and future tenses**. Express and justify opinions, preferences and ambitions. Manipulate language to communicate beyond memorised phrases.

Listening : Understand spoken French on familiar topics. Identify main points, details and opinions. Complete dictation tasks accurately.

Speaking: Communicate clearly and spontaneously in French. Take part in role-plays and conversations. Read aloud with accurate pronunciation. Describe and discuss visual stimuli, giving opinions and reasons.

Reading: Understand a range of written texts. Identify key information, opinions and implied meaning. Translate short passages from French into English.

Writing : Produce accurate written responses of varying lengths. Use a range of vocabulary and grammatical structures. Translate sentences from English into French. Write coherently using different tenses and justified opinions.

Cultural and Thematic Understanding Students study and communicate about **People and lifestyle** (identity, relationships, health, education and work) , **Popular culture** (free time, festivals, celebrations and celebrity culture) AND **Communication and the world around us** (travel, technology, media, environment and local area)
