1. Endpoint for the end of Key Stage 3:

- By the end of KS3, students will have developed a wide range of vocabulary on family and friends, leisure, French celebrations and school,
- Students will have learned to responsibly use a wide range of support resources and learning strategies to access and understand unfamiliar language and be creative in their own work.
- Students will have been introduced to phonics and a range of tenses.
- Students will have started learning strategies for reading such as context and cognates, which support the school GASE reading policy. They will use the vocabulary of language learning and better understand the role of grammar in learning another language.
