1	Violence in sport.	Read pages 167 – 171 in book. Read case studies. Complete table of notes. Answer exam Q's.	Details of case studies and specific exam Q's will be sent in weekly email.
2	Gambling in sport	Read pages 171 – 175 in book. Read case studies. Complete notes. Answer exam Q's. Revise for test next week on 4 Year 2 topics covered.	Details of case studies and specific exam Q's will be sent in weekly email.
3	Test week	Complete test in 60 minutes. Topics will be Modern Technology, Drugs, Violence and Gambling.	Test will be marked and feedback emailed to you. There may be follow up tasks.

1	Talent ID – UK Sport and National Institutes	Read pages 186-192 in book and make notes. For a sport of your choice write a summary of how a performer may progress from talented to elite.	
2	Strategies to avoid drop out and role of schools, colleges and universities.	Read pages 192 - 196 in book. Complete notes. Write a summary of your personal experience of progressing through a sport. Answer exam Q's on page 197.	
3	Revision week	Opportunity to organise notes, prepare revision resources and revise all topics ahead of looking at ten mark questions and test.	
4	Tackling the 10	Discussion of how to approach ten mark question including reference to mark schemes. Attempt three ten mark questions in 15, 12 and 10 minutes.	
5	Reviewing the 10	Peer review answers and suggest improvements. Revise ahead of test next week.
