In addition to the planned curriculum, students' experience is enhanced with a range of educational visits to support subject specific studies and input from a number of external presenters.

Curriculum extension opportunities exist to study for the Extended Project Qualification which is equal to half of an A level and involves 90 hours of independent research.

Each student is assigned a mentor who holds regular target setting and review meetings with the students and support them through their university, apprenticeship or job applications/preparation. The mentor will meet each student at least once per month.
