# **Year 8 French Curriculum Overview Autumn term**

## **Sequencing Rationale**

The first term of year 8 focuses on the topics of "**Holiday**" which introduces the future and conditional tense. Followed by the topic of the topics of "**Town**" which reiterates key vocabulary and high frequency words learnt in Year 7.

## Curriculum goals – topics and key skills covered (Studio 1 Module 6)

- 1. Holiday activities using the pronoun 'nous'
- 2. Countries and holiday destination
- 3. Understand the concept of prepositions 'en' 'au' 'aux' with countries
- 4. Revisit of main time phrases and frequency words and add new ones 'normalement' 'cette année'
- 5. Revisit of numbers 1 to 31 and intro of numbers 30 to 100 deconstructing numbers with maths. (91: four twenty eleven)
- 6. Students to understand prices in French
- 7. Food and drink items at a café and use of relevant phrases to use when ordering at a café
- 8. More holiday activities with intro of near future: understand the use of full paradigm of 'aller' and the infinitives
- 9. Intro of dreams and aspiration activities with **je voudrais +** infinitives
- 10. Recognise places in town
- 11. Describe a town/village saying what there is/isn't
- 12. Give your opinion about your town
- 13. Recognise and give directions
- 14. Say where you go using the verb "aller"+ place in town
- 15. Describe your ideal town
- 16. Invite someone to a place in town
- 17. Use modal verbs

#### Assessments

• Listening, writing and reading on the skills and knowledge mentioned above related to the module taught.

### How will more able students be extended and challenged

- Not looking at resources automatically
- Use of different pronouns to talk about other people
- Produce pieces of writing with present/ future and time expressions
- Use new opinions, high frequency words, connectives

### Classroom extra support

- Regular exposure/retrieval of key vocab
- Regular practise of common sentence starters
- Focus on regular verbs in the present/ future and I/he- she / we tense formation
- Focus on je voudrais + infinitive for the conditional tense
- Regular use of Vocab and grammar booklets for writing tasks
