Tectonic processes and Hazards	<p>This topic looks at the processes that pose a large risk to many part of the world. There are many places in world where there is an interaction between these dangerous processes and high population density. This topic addresses how and why some places are more vulnerable than others. This is looked at through three key questions</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Why some locations are more at risk from tectonic hazards?2) Why do some tectonic hazards develop into disasters?3) How successful is the management of tectonic hazards and disasters? <p>This question will be assessed through a range of shorter questions and 10 and 12 mark – ‘essay’ style questions.</p>	<p>Formal assessment: 45 minute end of topic assessment including skills questions, short answer questions and an extended writing task.</p> <p>Informal assessment:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• True/false quizzes• Homework• Review questions• Literacy tasks
Coastal Landscapes	<p>This Topic looks at how costal area change and can pose a risk. These landscapes are increasingly threatened from physical processes and human activities, and there is a need for holistic and sustainable management of these areas in all the world’s coasts. This is looked at through four key questions</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Why are costal landscape different and what causes those differences?2. How do characteristic costal landform contribute to other costal landscapes?3. How do costal erosion and sea level change alter the physical characteristics of coastline and increase risk?4.
