Key Learning Points

Students will continue working on their R022 coursework.

The two tasks that will be completed during the start of the autumn term are:

- 1. Researching qualities a care worker should possess and qualities that are specific to a job role
- 2. Demonstrating positive communication methods through a series of set tasks. Students will demonstrate a one to one roleplay and a group roleplay.

Assessment will take place with the overall grading of the coursework. Students work will be continually assessed and feedback given in order for improvements to be made.

Key Learning Points

Students will start their RO28 coursework - Understanding the development and protection of young children in an early years setting.

The two tasks that will be completed this term are:

- 1. Provide information on the key milestones of physical, intellectual and language development of a child between 0-5 years old and explain how a case study of a child compares with the key milestones of child development.
- 2. Provide information on key milestones of emotional and social development between 0-5 years and explain how a case study of a child compares with key milestones.

Assessment will take place with the overall grading of the coursework. Students work will be continually assessed and feedback given in order for improvements to be made.
