<b>Performing</b>	<p><i>End Point: to perform a piece of music as part of an ensemble</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will form small ensembles among themselves and rehearse and perform a suitable piece of music</li> <li>• Students will gain an understanding of the requirements for GCSE Ensemble performance and how they can meet the criteria for this part of the course</li> <li>• Students will be given the opportunity to perform these ensemble pieces at the Summer Showcase</li> </ul>	Students' performance skills will be monitored and assessed through verbal feedback from teacher and peers. Students will also be encouraged to self-assess their own performances.
<b>Composing</b>	<p><i>End Point: to compose a piece of music in any style</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Students will develop their understanding of melodic development</li> <li>• Students will learn how to showcase their understanding of the elements of music through their compositions</li> <li>• Students will plan and then compose (either on instruments or software) a piece of music of their own choice</li> <li>• Students will write composition 'log books', explaining and justifying their decisions and the techniques they have used</li> <li>• Students will gain an understanding of the requirements for GCSE Free Composition and how they can meet the criteria for this part of the course</li> </ul>	Students' compositions will be monitored and assessed through verbal feedback from teacher and peers. Students will also be encouraged to self-assess their own compositions.
