Key Learning Points

- How autism can affect development
- How to create a safe environment to protect children in an early years setting

Students will complete their RO28 coursework - Understanding the Development and Protection of Young Children in an Early Years Setting:

The tasks that will be completed this term are:

- 1. Provide information on the key milestones of physical, intellectual and language development of a child between 0-5 years old and explain how a case study of a child compares with the key milestones of child development.
- 2. Provide information on key milestones of emotional and social development between 0-5 years and explain how a case study of a child compares with key milestones.
- 3. Explain how the case studies of a child compare with the key milestones

Assessment will take place with the overall grading of the coursework. Students work will be continually assessed and feedback given in order for improvements to be made.
