Dear Year 11 and Year 13 Students, Parents and Carers

I am writing to inform you of the preparations for results days and the collection of results. The results day for Year 13 students will be on Thursday 15 August and the results day for Year 11 students will be on Thursday 22 August, please see further information below.

A large number of staff, including members of the senior leadership team and teaching staff, will be around on results day to discuss results with students and parents/carers. Students are encouraged to ask any questions that might help them, including questions about post results services and next steps.

A Level & Level 3 Vocational Courses Results Day: Thursday 15 August

Students will be able to collect results in person between 8.00am and 10.30am in the Sixth Form building. If your child will not be able to collect their results in person on the day, please complete the form at the end of this letter. In order to meet GDPR regulations, we will only accept either a hard copy signed by the student or an email request from the student's JMHS email account. NO OTHER MEANS WILL BE ACCEPTED. The email request should be made to our Exams Officer, Mr Peggs at exams.officer@jmhs.hereford.sch.uk Any hard copy should also be returned to Mr Peggs. Enclosed in each student's results envelope will be key information related to results, including Post Results Services information (this includes Access to Scripts and Reviews of Marking).

Competition for university places is usually strong most years and so it is very important that students who have made a UCAS application are in school on results day to instigate the 'clearing' process with the support of experienced members of staff, if required. Having parents/carers at hand to support them is also useful.

Ahead of the day it will be extremely useful for students to explore what 'clearing' is and how to use it. This is particularly the case if, although you will not definitively know your results until results day, you suspect that you may not have done as well in the exams as you would have liked and may not therefore meet the grade requirements of your university offer. It will also be relevant if you have changed your mind about the university or course you have chosen on UCAS. You can find out more about clearing and get prepared by visiting the following sites:

GCSE Results Day: Thursday 22 August

The results day for Year 11 students will be Thursday 22 August, between 9.00 am and 11.00 am in the Sixth Form building.

Each student will be able to collect their results in person. If your child will not be able to collect their results in person on the day, please complete the form at the end of this letter. In order to meet GDPR regulations, we will only accept either a hard copy signed by the student or an email request from the student's JMHS email account. **NO OTHER MEANS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Enclosed in each student's results envelope will be key information related to results, including Post Results Services information (this includes Access to Scripts and Reviews of Marking).

Sixth Form Enrolment 2024

The enrolment procedures for the Sixth Form will be based on a student's results and their subject decisions.

If they have applied for a place in the Sixth Form and have gained the grades required, they will have an acceptance letter for the Sixth Form in the exam results pack and will receive an email from the Sixth Form team with further information on how to enrol online. This will be a very quick and easy process, and we will then look forward to seeing students on Wednesday 4 September. However, there will also be members of the Sixth Form team available on the GCSE results day to offer support with enrolment.

If students have not quite achieved the grades, or if they would like to consider a different course then they will need to attend the enrolment day on Tuesday 27 August between 10:00 and 14:00. This will give them time to process their results and to consider options for moving forward. Students can book an appointment slot to meet with a member of the Sixth Form team on the enrolment day, in person on the GCSE results day or via email, by emailing the Head of Sixth Form, Mrs Laidler at ana.laidler@jmhs.hereford.sch.uk .

For students not intending to join our Sixth Form, our Careers Adviser will also be available in school to provide help on results day.

Lastly, any remaining school text books can be returned on results day.
