Thank you again to those of you that were able to join us last night for Transition Evening. I have outlined below a few key reminders about Transition Day.

Transition Day – Thursday 3 July 2025

Transport: A reminder that your son/daughter needs to be at JMHS between 8.30am and 8.45am. If you are dropping off by car then we would ask that you do so just before 8.30am or just after 8.45am to avoid the busy period with buses. There will be staff and prefects available to direct students to the theatre. Public service buses can be used by paying, but designated school buses are unavailable to Year 6 students. Those students walking home at the end of the day will be allowed to leave school site at 3pm. If you are collecting by car, please be on site before 3pm and wait by school reception. For those using public service buses, we will help them find the right bus.

Uniform: We ask that all students wear their primary school PE kit and trainers. All students will have the opportunity to take part in a House sports event in the afternoon.

Dining Room: Lunch will be provided free of charge and there will be a range of hot and cold food available.
